**OF USE AND PLACE OF USE OF THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF**

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The applicant **James R. Boyce**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Manner & Place of Use** of water heretofore appropriated under Permit **44542**

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1. The source of water is **McAfee Creek**
2. The amount of water to be changed **2.8 c.f.s., not to exceed 2,026.6 acre-feet ann.**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 25, T.3S., R.35E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Corner of said Section 25, bears N. 30°41' W., a distance of 2815.0 feet**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 2, T.4S., R.35E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner of said Section 2, bears N. 58°59' E., a distance of 2664.4 feet. Refer to map filed under Permit 44542.**
7. Proposed place of use **See Attachment "A"**
8. Existing place of use **See Attachment "B"**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Pump in ditch at southern boundary of property, thence via wheel lines and pivots to the place of use.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$50,000.00**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Three (3) years**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **Five (5) years**
15. Remarks: **This application is being filed to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 44542 in order to fully utilize the extent of the right. The proposed place of use will conform with the remaining place of use as delineated in the letter of withdrawal to the State Engineer dated June 23, 2003. Water will be co-mingled with surface rights under Permits 44543, 44544 and 44550 and with the remaining portion of**

underground rights under Permits 44540, 44548, 44549, 52183 and 52184 for the irrigation of a total of 447.15 acres.

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of the waters of McAfee Creek as heretofore granted under Permit 44542, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 44542, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total acres irrigated on the southern portion of the ranch by Permits 44540, 44548, 44549, 52183, 52184 and 70471 through 70474 shall be limited to 162.5 acres from surface sources, plus 307.3 acres from non-supplemental underground sources, for a total of 469.8 acres irrigated from all sources within the common described place of use.

The total combined duty of underground water on the southern portion of the ranch under Permits 44540, 44548, 44549, 52183 and 52184 shall be limited to 1,536.5 acre-feet annually (AFA) for non-supplemental underground water, plus 423.5 AFA for supplemental underground water, for a maximum total combined duty of underground water of 1,960.0 AFA.

The total combined diversion rate and duty of the well containing Permits 44540, 44548 and 44549 shall be limited to 2.799 CFS and 812.68 AFA, respectively.

The total combined diversion rate and duty of the well containing Permits 52183 and 52184 shall be limited to 2.715 CFS and 1,316.97 AFA, respectively.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped under Permits 44540, 44548, 44549, 52183 and 52184, and the pumping records shall be submitted to the State Engineer on February 15<sup>th</sup> of each year.

Surface water rights from McAfee Creek under Permits 70471 through 70474, are junior in priority to McAfee Creek and Tributaries Decree, Proof 02733.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.8 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 2,026.63 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

January 12, 2007

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

February 12, 2007

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

January 12, 2011

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

February 12, 2011

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

February 12, 2011


