

The applicant **Running W Ranch** hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association give names of members.) **Bingo G. Wesner, Karen Wesner, Bing G. Wesner**

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **an underground source**
2. The amount of water applied for is **12.00 cfs** second-feet
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for **irrigation purposes**
4. If use is for:
 - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated **639 acres**
 - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered
 - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")
 - (d) Power:
 - (1) Horsepower developed
 - (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point **within the NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ of Section 22, T.27N., R.31E., MDB&M or at a point from which the W¹/₂ corner of said Section 22 bears N 45° W 250 feet**
6. Place of Use **203 acres in Section 21, 130 acres in the SW¹/₄ of Section 22, 53 acres in the NE¹/₄ of Section 29, and 253 acres within portions of Sections 29, 30, 31, and 32, all in T.27N., R.31E., MDB&M – 639 acres**
7. Use will begin about **January 1** and end about **December 31** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **drill well, install pump and pipelines**
9. Estimated cost of works **in excess of \$5,000**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **2 years**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**
12. Remarks: **Water is to be supplemental to existing surface water from the Humboldt River.**
