The applicant **LYON COUNTY**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Place of Use and Manner of Use of a Portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 50557**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **2.78 cfs NTE 25 AFA**
3. The water to be used for **Construction Purposes**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Quase-Municipal & Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T.16N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 27 bears S. 15°34'06" E., a distance of 1789 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **No Change**
7. Proposed place of use **Portions of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 26; Portions of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, all within T.16N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.**

Existing place of use **SE $\frac{1}{4}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28; SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Portions of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27; Portions of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34; N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T.16N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.**
9. Use will be from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **drilled and cased well, pump, motor and distribution system.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$100,000.00**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Completed under Permit 50557**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **One (1) year**
15. Remarks: **Water will be pumped from a stand pipe and used for construction purposes, grading and dust suppression for Phase 1 of Santa Maria Ranch Development within APN 16-261-05. This water will supplement Carson River Claim 716 under Temporary Application 70691T**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the place of use and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 50557 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 50557 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

A separate meter will be required for the water to be used for construction purposes.

The combined diversion rate for Permit 50557 and Temporary Permit 70692-T shall not exceed 2.78 cubic feet per second.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **March 23, 2005** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed **2.78** cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 25 acre-feet annually**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:
