The applicant **Colorado River Commission of Nevada ("CRC")**, and **Lake Las Vegas Joint Venture ("LLV")** hereb makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. **Lake Las Vegas Joint Venture is a copartnership comprised of TransNeva Limited Partnership, Managing Partner and TransLoch Limited Partnership, General Partner**

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **all storm and flood water which falls within a calendar year within the Las Vegas valley watershed, notwithstanding where it may flow or may be retained, exclusive of that appropriated under Permit 58390, Cert. 14303 & Permit 29814.**

THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA****2. The amount of water applied for is:**

All storm and flood water described in the attached Joint Permit Application in the answer to question 1, not to exceed a probable maximum flood, the normalized annual resource volume of which is estimated not to exceed 10,000 acre-feet and which normalized annual resource volume shall be established through demonstration of beneficial use.

**5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point:**

Either at (1) Lake Las Vegas Resort, SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 22, T21S, R63E, MDM, at a point from which the SW corner of Section 22 is s62 degrees 48'21" W a distance of 1652.13'; (2) Saddle Island at Lake Mead; (3) the mouth of the Las Vegas Wash at Lake Mead; or (4) *in situ* diversion.

**12. Remarks:**

CRC and LLV intend to exercise their respective rights under a joint permit for appropriation and storage from the State Engineer in a manner that (1) enables the CRC to maximize its ability to enhance the State of Nevada's rights to Colorado River water, including mechanisms for LLV to use water resources alternative to Colorado River water (2) enables the CRC to maintain its protection of Colorado River return flow credits under Colorado River Decree Accounting and (3) maximizes the amount of storm water flows that LLV may store and use currently and in the future.
