The applicant **Wolfgang O. & Ursula Eisenhut 1989 Revocable Trust** hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion and Place of Use** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit No. 49416**

1. The source of water is **underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **6.60 acre-feet, 0.0221 cfs**
3. The water to be used for **Quasi-Municipal and Domestic Purposes**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Quasi-Municipal and Domestic Purposes**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, T.12N., R.19E., M.D.M. or at a point from which the W1/16 S14/23 corner of said Section 14 bears South 67°08'50" West, a distance of 252 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T.13N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 23 bears South 82°37' East, 2360 feet**
7. Proposed place of use **0.98 acres within a portion of 1.65 acres within a portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, all in Section 14, T.12N., R.19E., M.D.M., Douglas County, Nevada**

12. Estimated cost of works **Unknown**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **One (1) Year**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **Five (5) Years**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore ore granted under Permit 49416 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 49416 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0221 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 6.60 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

March 22, 2006

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 22, 2006

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

March 22, 2010

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

April 22, 2010


