The applicant Douglas County, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Manner & Place of Use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 57541

- 1. The source of water is Underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.985 c.f.s., not to exceed 32.5 acre-feet
3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal & Domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation & Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 6, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 Corner of said Section 6 bears N. 20°43'23" W., a distance of 1322.03 feet. See map filed under Permit 69007.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 16, T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at at point from which the E 1/4 Corner of said Section 16 bears N. 84°30'00" E., a distance of 3400 feet. See map filed under Permit 57541.
7. Proposed place of use See Exhibit "A" and supporting map
8. Existing place of use Portions of the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 16, T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. See map filed under Permit 57541. The entire place of use is being removed from irrigation by this application.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Drilled and cased well equipped with pump, motor, meter and municipal distribution system.
12. Estimated cost of works \$250,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works Two (2) years
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use Ten (10) years
15. Remarks: Water being changed by this application is to be transferred into the Douglas County water system and used for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes within the proposed place of use. Both the existing and proposed points of diversion are located within

Basin 104 (Eagle Valley). Documents transferring Permit 57541 to Douglas County will be submitted prior to this permit being ready for action.
