The applicant Randy Venturacci, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Dry Valley Creek and Tributaries
2. The amount of water applied for is 5.0 c.f.s. second-feet
(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic purposes
