The applicant **Robert C. Vesco & Diana L. Vesco Vance R. Vesco & Jody Vesco**, hereby make application for permission to change the **place of use** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 51431**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **5.4 Second Feet**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation and Domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **Within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2 T28N, R38E, M.D.M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 2 bears N 9° 58' E a distance of 2,878.3 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **Within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2 T28N, R38E, M.D.M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 2 bears N 9° 58' EE a distance of 2,878.3 feet.**
7. 12. Estimated cost of works **\$10,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Completed**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **10 years**

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15. Remarks: **This application is made to clarify and more accurately define the actual place of use under this permit. The total combined duty of water under Permit 21242, certificate 7298, and this application shall not exceed 1,280 acre-feet annually.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 51431 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 51431 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 21242, Certificate 7298 and 71381 shall not exceed 5.4 cubic feet per second and 1280.0 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The diversion rate of Permit 21242, Certificate 7298 and this permit shall not exceed 5.4 cubic feet per second.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 5.4 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources, but not to exceed 1280.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

June 9, 2006

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

July 9, 2006

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

June 9, 2008

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

July 9, 2008


