The applicant **Martha P. Sims** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion of a Portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 66816**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **1.5 cfs**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation and Domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, T.34N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. at a point from which the West $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of Section 11, T.34N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. bears S 37°23'18" W, 3512.27 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, T.34N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. at a point from which the West $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of said Section 2 bears, N 25°48'13" W, 2912.35 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 2, and all of Section 11, all in T.34N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. (320 Acres)**
8. Existing place of use **W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 2, and all of Section 11, all in T.34N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M (320 Acres) (Same as proposed)**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Drilled well, pipelines and sprinkler system**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$10,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **1 year**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **1 year**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 66816 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 66816 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 66815, 66816, 69069, 69070 and Temporary Permit 71448-T shall not exceed 3,200 acre-feet annually.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **November 3, 2005** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

All surface waters must be used for irrigation prior to the use of any of the supplemental ground water

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 640 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:
