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The applicant **Lawrence C. Masini Ranch** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 58754**

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1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **3.0 c.f.s., 300.8 AFA**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation and Domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic**

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 58754 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 58754 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total land irrigated under Permits 58752, 58753, 58755, 58756, 58757, 58758, 58759, 71553 and any water of the Walker River Decree and any storage water appurtenant to the place of use shall not exceed 1316.7 acres within the described place of use.

These permits for underground water are issued as a supplemental water supply to lands that have a surface water right from the Walker River as set forth in the Walker River Decree C-125, or from storage water provided from the Walker River Irrigation District. The total diversion of water for irrigation from any and all sources shall not exceed the duty of water for this place of use as set forth in the Decree. Underground water shall not be pumped from the wells described in these permits except to the extent necessary to make up the portion of the entitled duty from Decree and storage water in any given year.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second, or 300.8 acre-feet per season.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

March 1, 2007

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 1, 2007

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

March 1, 2009

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

April 1, 2009


