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The applicant **Silverado Inc.**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of diversion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 18914, Certificate 5275**

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1. The source of water is **underground**

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 14 T. 12 N R 25 E M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Sec 14 bears N. 36° 56' E 2,653.02 feet**

9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.

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## APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 18914, Certificate 5275 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 18914, Certificate 5275 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 71563-T and 18654, Certificate 5274 shall not exceed 880.8 acre-feet per year.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **September 12, 2005** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.98 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 880.8 acre-feet per year, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:



Temporary Application to Change No. 71563 - T proposes to change only the point of diversion of Permit No. 18914. The proposed place of use under this temporary is the same as the existing place of use. The existing well under Permit No. 18914 has been in existence for over 40 years and is no longer producing enough to satisfy the demand and water is needed to complete this years irrigation.
