

**AMENDED****THE STATE OF NEVADA****PERMIT TO CHANGE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE
STATE OF NEVADA HERETOFORE APPROPRIATED**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 65778, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 65778 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of groundwater under Permit 18729, Certificate 7236; Permit 25201, Certificate 8955; Permit 30409, Certificate 10422; Permit 51014, Certificate 12836; Permit 71680, Permit 71681, Permit 71682, and Permit 79492 shall not exceed 3,663.71 acre-feet annually, for the irrigation of 915.9275 acres within the described place of use. These permits for underground water are issued as a supplemental water supply to lands that have surface water rights from the Walker River as set forth in Claim Numbers 76 and 7 (changed via Permit 63325) of the Walker River Decree C-125, or from storage water provided from the Walker River Irrigation District. The total diversion of water for irrigation from any and all sources shall not exceed the duty of water for this place of use as set forth in the Decree. Underground water shall not be pumped from the wells described in these permits except to the extent necessary to make up the portion of the entitled duty from Decree and storage water in any given year.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.875 cubic feet per second or 149.33 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

December 22, 2015

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


