The applicant **Joyce L. Lohr**, hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit No. 54988**

1. The source of water is **underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **1.72 cfs**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation and Domestic Use**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic Use**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **within lot 2 Section 18, T.19N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M.; or at a point from which the W¹/₄ of said Section 18 bears S 52° 14' W, a distance of 1520.00 feet**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **lot 4 Section 18, T.19N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M.; from a point that bears N 12° 09' 20" W, a distance of 770.00 feet to the Northwest corner of said lot 4.**
7. Proposed place of use **unchanged**
8. Existing place of use **lots 2, 3, 4, SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄, SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ of Section 18, T.19N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M. for a total of 232.64 acres.**
9. Use will be from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **drill well, install pump & electric motor & irrigation system**
12. Estimated cost of works **in excess of \$25,000.00**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **3 years**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 54988 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 54988 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 54988 and 71958 shall not exceed 650.56 acre-feet annually.

Any well drilled under this permit shall be drilled in what has been described in the United States Geological Survey Water Supply Paper 2263 as the intermediate alluvial aquifer. In no instance shall the seal on this well be less than 100 feet below ground level.

This permit is limited to the irrigation of 162.64 acres within the described place of use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.72 cubic feet per second, **and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

December 13, 2006

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

January 13, 2007

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

October 1, 2008

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

November 1, 2008

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

November 1, 2008
