APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance issued under the provisions of NRS 533.371 for a finite period of time. This permit will expire on **December 31, 2016** and all rights herein will revert back to the source. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.2 cubic feet per second or 10.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

August 10 2012

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



The applicant **RTI Railroad Services, Inc.** makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. **January 6, 2004, State of Nevada, File Number C165-2004.**

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **underground**
2. The amount of water applied for is **3.285 million gallons annually at 0.2 cfs second-feet**
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for **Industrial and domestic**
4. If use is for:
 - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated
 - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered
 - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")
 - (d) Power:
 - (1) Horsepower developed
 - (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point **within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, T.27N., R.19E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the southwest corner of said Section 30 bears South 84° 49' West a distance of 3188 feet.**
6. Place of Use **portions of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30 and portions of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, T.27N., R.19E., M.D.M., within Washoe County Assessor's Parcel Number 074-131-07.**
7. Use will begin about **January 1** and end about **December 31** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **Drilled well, pump, meter and pipeline.**
9. Estimated cost of works in excess of \$100,000
10. Estimated time required to construct works **3 years**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**

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12. Remarks: RTI Railroad Services has been operating a railroad tie crushing and recycling facility in northern Washoe County. Water is currently obtained off-site and trucked in. Water from the proposed well would be used for dust control, landscaping irrigation, fire safety and to supply water to a commercial coach. The well would supply water to the commercial coach for use of full restroom facilities and a shower for the employees.
