The applicant **SILVER SPRINGS MUTUAL WATER COMPANY** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Place and Manner of Use of a Portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 28555, Certificate 9838**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **1.656 cfs 204.48 AFA**
3. The water to be used for **Quasi-Municipal**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NE¼ NE¼ Section 30, T.18N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 30 bears N. 80° 38' 32" E., a distance of 802.00 feet (Lake Street Well #2).**

9. Use will be from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 28555, Certificate 9838, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 28555, Certificate 9838, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The permittee shall report to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis the effect of pumping the well under this permit on other previously existing wells that are located within 2,500 feet of the well under this permit.

Any pumping of water under this permit may be limited or prohibited to prevent any unreasonable adverse effects on an existing domestic well located within 2,500 feet of the well under this permit, unless the holder of this permit and the owner of the domestic well have agreed to alternative measures that mitigate adverse effects.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 36636, 36637, 36638, 36639, 36640, 62912, 62913, 60749, 60751, 60752, 60753, 62586, 66171, 66172, 66173, 72096, 72097, 72438, 72619 and 73525 shall not exceed 4,550.56 acre-feet annually.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The permittee shall report to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis the effect of pumping the well under this permit on other previously existing wells that are located within 2,500 feet of the well under this permit.

Any pumping of water under this permit may be limited or prohibited to prevent any unreasonable adverse effects on an existing domestic well located within 2,500 feet of the well under this permit, unless the holder of this permit and the owner of the domestic well have agreed to alternative measures that mitigate adverse effects.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 36636, 36637, 36638, 36639, 36640, 62912, 62913, 60749, 60751, 60752, 60753, 62586, 66171, 66172, 66173, 72096 and 72097 shall not exceed 3698.93 acre-feet annually.

This permit is issued for the consumptive use portion only of the original irrigation base right (Permit 28555, Certificate 9838), being 127.80 acre-feet. The remainder of this portion of the base right (76.68 acre-feet) remains in the ground water source.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.


