This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This amended permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 54988 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 54988 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This amended permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this amended permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Any well drilled under this amended permit shall be drilled in what has been described in the United States Geological Survey Water Supply Paper 2263 as the intermediate alluvial aquifer. In no instance shall the seal on this well be less than 100 feet below ground level.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 54888, 54856, 62442, 67051, 72136 and 72137 shall not exceed 454.80 acre feet annually.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.527 cubic feet per second or 140.0 acre-feet annually.**

The total combined duty of water under Permits 54855, 54856, 62441, 62442, 67051, 67052, 72136 and 72137 shall not exceed 384.10 acre-feet annually.

This permit is issued for the consumptive use portion only of the original irrigation base right (Permit 54988), being 104.65 acre-feet. The remainder of this portion of the base right (35.35 acre-feet) remains in the ground water source.
