The applicant **Albert and Georgia Harrison** make application for permission to change the **point of diversion and place of use** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 71074**

1. The source of water is **underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **1.82 CFS**
3. The water to be used for **irrigation & domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **irrigation & domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **withing** the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, T.38N, R.36E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 13 bears S 45° W, a distance of 300.00 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within Lot 5 SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25, T.39N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE Corner of said Section 25 bears S 44° 56' E, a distance of 63.6 feet.
7. Proposed place of use **W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 13, T.38N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M. 240.18 acres**
8. Existing place of use **Section 25, T.39N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M. 480.36 acres, 240.18 acres are to be removed from the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Section 25.**
9. Use will be from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **drilled well, buried pipeline and circular sprinkler.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$100,000±**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **2 years**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **3 years**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 71074 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 71074 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030.

The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 72190 and 72191 shall not exceed 960.72 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Approval of Permits 72190 and 72191 reduces the duty remaining under Permit 71073 to 960.72 acre-feet annually.

Approval of Permit 72191 fully abrogates Permit 71074.

This permit is issued for the irrigation of 240.18 acres within the described place of use.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.820 cubic feet per second, or 960.72 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

February 9, 2009

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

February 9, 2012

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

February 9, 2012


