The applicant **Michael A. and Michelle A. Sturge** hereby make application for permission to change the **Place and Manner of Use, of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit No. 30992 (Cert. No. 9832)**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **8.88 Acre-Feet – 0.045 CFS**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation and Domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **within the NE¼ NE¼ of Section 6, T12N, R26E, M.D.M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 6 bears N. 49° 13' 00" East, a distance of 1911.24 feet. Refer to Supporting Map filed under Permit No. 30992 (Cert. No. 9832).**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within
7. Proposed place of use **2.22 Acres within the NE¼ NE¼ of Section 6, T12N, R26E, M.D.M. Parcel No. 12-171-11 Refer to Supporting Map filed with this application.**
8. Existing place of use **Land to which the water (475.6 AF) is appurtenant: 40.5 Acres in the NE¼ NE¼ of Section 6, T12N, R26E, M.D.M. 39.2 Acres in the NW¼ NW¼ of Section 5, T12N, R26E, M.D.M. 39.2 Acres in the NE¼ NW¼ of Section 5, T12n, R26E, M.D.M. A total of 118.9 Acres. Refer to Supporting Map filed under Permit No. 30992 (Cert. 9832)**
***Removing 2.22 Acres from Irrigation**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **April 1 to November 30** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Water diverted from existing point, via additional piping to pasture. Also piping and pumping to new residence on property for domestic use.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$15,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Two (2) years.**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **Five (5) years.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the manner and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 30992, Certificate 9832 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 30992, Certificate 9832 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total land irrigated under Permit 72241, and any water of the Walker River Decree and any storage water appurtenant to the place of use shall not exceed 2.22 acres within the described place of use.

This permit for underground water is issued as supplemental water supply to lands that have a surface water right from the East Walker River as set forth in the Walker River Decree C-125, or from storage water provided from the Walker River Irrigation District. The total diversion of water for irrigation from any and all sources shall not exceed the duty of water for this place of use as set forth in the Decree.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0448 cubic feet per second, 8.88 acre-feet per season.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:
March 10, 2007

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:
April 10, 2007

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:
March 10, 2009

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
April 10, 2009

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
April 10, 2009
