The applicant **Adaven Management, Inc.** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 70325**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.36 cfs, 260.0 acre-feet**
3. The water to be used for **Quasi-municipal**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Quasi-municipal**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 3, T. 21S., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 3 bears S. 54°00W., a distance of 1,318.0 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 3, T.21S, R.54E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the N $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Sec. 3 bears N. 0° 57'E., a distance of 3,475 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **Portion S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 3; Portion N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Portion NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Portion SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, and Portion S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 6; E $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. 8; W $\frac{1}{2}$ and Portion NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 9; NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Portion NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 10; N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 16; and N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 17, all in T21S., R54E., MDM**
8. Existing place of use **Portions of Sections 3, 4, 5, and 6, T.21S., R.54E., MDB&M.**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Drilled well, pump and motor, and water distribution system**
12. Estimated cost of works **Unknown (well drilled and equipped by prior owner)**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Drilled well with 16" casing to 96' and 12" casing from 70' to 730'. Equipped with vertical turbine pump and 100 hp electric motor per P. 22735 Proof of Comp.**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **10 years**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 70325 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 70325 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

Approval of this application reduces the total combined duty of Permits 70325, 70326 and 70327 to 1494.196 acre-feet annually.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.36 cubic feet per second, not to exceed 260.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

March 15, 2007

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 15, 2007

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

March 15, 2016

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

April 15, 2016

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
