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#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This corrected permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 57254, Certificate 15083, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 57254, Certificate 15083, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 18654, Certificate 5274; Permits 72131 and 72402 shall not exceed 1,062.02 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 265.505 acres within the described place of use.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.793 cubic feet per second, or 181.22 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed an annual duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.



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The applicant **James T. Ammons and Susan R. Ammons** hereby makes application for permission to change the **point of diversion and place of use of a portion of water** heretofore appropriated under **Permit No. 57254 (Certificate No. 15083)**

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1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **181.22 ac.ft./prorata share of the diversion rate**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation and Domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic**

**Application to Change No. 72402**  
**Applicant: James T. Ammons and Susan R. Ammons**

Mica Farms, LLC has purchased land and appurtenant water rights under Permit Nos. 18654, 18914 and pending Application to Change No. 72131 from Silverado, Inc.

Mica Farms, LLC has purchased "primary - stand alone" ground water rights under Permit No. 57254 (Certificate No. 15083) and pending Application to Change No. 72402 from James T. Ammons and Susan R. Ammons.

Reports of Conveyance, abstracts of water right title and copies of documents are being prepared and will be filed with the State Engineer's office.

Application to Change No. 72402 proposes to change the point of diversion to an existing well drilled under Application to Change No. 72131.

The proposed place of use noted within Application to Change No. 72402 contains acres irrigated by decreed surface water rights under Walker River Decree Claim Nos. 84, 108 & 164 and by storage surface water rights administered by the Walker River Irrigation District. By filing Application to Change No. 72402, the applicant intends to utilize the "primary - stand alone" ground water as both a supplemental and "primary - stand alone" source of water within the proposed place of use. The applicant also intends to file future applications to move the "primary - stand alone" water identified under Application No. 72402 to other locations and retain the "primary - stand alone" status of these rights.
