The applicant **Southern Nevada Water Authority** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of diversion and Place of use of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 54066**

1. The source of water is **UGW - Well**
2. The amount of water to be changed **3.33 cfs**
3. The water to be used for **No Change**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Municipal & Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **Gov't Lot 9 .Sec 34, T.16S, R.57E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE cor of said sec 34 bears S. 67 degrees 29' 48" E. a distance of 665.30 feet (211 W. 105)**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **NW¼ SE¼ Section 27, T.14S., R.59E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 13 T.16S., R.56E. M.D.B.&M., bears S. 55 Degrees 04' 14" W., a distance of 99,582 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **Clark County (See Ruling #5465) page 56**
8. Existing place of use **Clark County, Nye County, Lincoln County and White Pine County**
9. Use will be from **1/1 to 12/31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **1/1 to 12/31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Drilled well, pump, motor and distribution lines**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$500,000.00**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **5 years**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **10 years**

15. Remarks: For existing P.O.D. P.O.U. use map on file under permit 54066. For proposed P.O.D. use map to accompany this application. For proposed P.O.U. use Clark County as defined in NRS 243.035. The duty under this application and two additional changes of permit 54066 as well as three changes of permit 54062 shall be limited to 2618 AFA. Duty under the three changes of 54066 along with changes of permits 53950, 53951, 54060, 54062, 54068 and 54069 shall be limited to 8018 AFA

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 54066 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 54066 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 72792, 72793, 72794, 72795, 72796 and 72797 shall not exceed 2618.0 acre-feet annually.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

A monitoring program must be approved by the State Engineer prior to the diversion of any of the water permitted for appropriation under this permit.

If significant impacts to existing water rights are demonstrated, the applicant, or any assignee, will be required to mitigate the same, up to and including cessation of pumping. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The place of use of water appropriated by this permit is restricted to Clark County, Nevada.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.33 cubic feet per second.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

July 31, 2011

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

August 31, 2011

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

July 31, 2016

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

August 31, 2016

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
