The applicant LYON COUNTY, c/o Lyon County Utilities hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion & Place and Manner of Use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 26232, Certificate 13659**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.81 cfs 65.17 MGA (200 AFA)**
3. The water to be used for **Quasi-Municipal**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Mining, Milling & Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T. 17 N., R. 22 E. M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 33 bears S. 13° 28' 09" W., a distance of 558.09 feet (per Cert. 13658) (Cardelli Well). Note: Application 19978 & Supporting Map show P.O.D. as S. 13° 40' W., 558.10 feet.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, manner of use and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 26232, Certificate 13659, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 26232, Certificate 13659, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 49483 and 49486, Certificate 14718; Permits 50361 and 56593, Certificate 14706; Permit 58931, Certificate 14719; Permits 58932 and 58933, Certificate 14720; Permits 58934, 62937 and 62938, Certificate 15662; Permits 62939, 62940, 63626, 63628, 63630, 63632, 63633, 64128, 64782, 64783, 64784, 64785, 64957, 66427, 68155, 68156, 68196, 68197, 68198, 68708, 68737, 69243, 69244, 69245, 70040, 70041, 70042, 70693, 70846, 71379, 71476, 71477, 71536, 71537, 71688, 71856, 71857, 71872, 71873, 72603, 72774, 72775, 72914, 72931, 72932, 72933, 73157, 73158 and 73183 shall not exceed 7550.83 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The issuance of this permit totally abrogates Permit 26232, Certificate 13659.
