APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 68769 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 68769 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 68767, 68768, 68770, 68771, 68772, 68773, 68774, 68776, 68777, 69415, 69416, 69417, 69418, 71051, 71052, 71054, 71055, 71056, 71057, 71058, 72979, 74804, 74805, 74806, 74807, 74808, 74809 and 77139 shall not exceed 7801.67 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 1909.36 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.2992 cubic feet per second or 145.14 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

February 12 2016

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





The applicant **Rightway Investments Smith Valley, LLC** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 68769**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.2992 cfs – 145.14 AFA**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation and Domestic Uses**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic Uses**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **SE¼ SW¼ of Section 26, T13N, R23E, MDM. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 26 bears S 76 degrees 33 minutes W, a distance of 1,312 feet**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SE¼ SW¼ of Section 34, T13N, R23E, MDM or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 34 bears N 18°10'59"W, a distance of 4,414.34 feet**
7. Proposed place of use **Same as existing Place of Use.**

Existing place of use **portions of the following: NW¼ and N1/2 SW¼ Section 3, and the NE¼ SE¼ Section 4, T 12N, R 23E, MDM,; NE¼ and E1/2 NW¼, NE¼ SW¼ and the NW¼ SE¼ and the S1/2 SW¼ Section 34, T13N, R23E, MDM.; N1/2 N1/2 and the SW¼ NW¼ Section 35, T13N, R23E, MDM.; All of Section 26, T13N, R23E, MDM.; SE¼ SW¼, S1/2 NE¼ and the SE¼ Section 27, T13N, R23E, MDM.**
9. Use will be from **January 1ST to December 31ST** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1ST to December 31ST** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Drilled well, pump, motor and distribution system**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$100,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **2 years**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**
