The applicant **Margaret Crockett, Trustee of the Margaret Crockett Trust** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Manner of Use and Place of Use a portion of** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 61871, being 3 acre feet**

1. The source of water is **underground; Las Vegas Artisan Basin**
2. The amount of water to be changed **3 acre feet**
3. The water to be used for **Quasi-Municipal and Domestic uses**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Commercial uses**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, T22S, R60E, at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 14 bears South 41° 09'25" West at a distance of 1,360 feet, Clark County, Nevada.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, T19S, R62E, at a point from whence the Northwest corner of said Section 25 bears North 3° West a distance of 2,200 feet, Clark County, Nevada (from Permit 61871 Well T-2)**
7. Proposed place of use **within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, T22S, R60E, M.D.M. APN 176-14-801-012**
8. Existing place of use **See Attachment 1**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Water is to be diverted by an existing well, pump and motor.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$11,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Well is complete. Well is a 483 foot, 8 inch cased well with a 5HP25GS50 Goulds 25 GPM pump and 5 Hp Franklin 4 inch submersible motor set 462 feet on a 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " pipe. 3000 gallon tank, Goulds 3656 3 Hp 1 ph booster pump and 2 inch Dole valve 30 GPM**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 61871 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 61871 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

Permit 73051 is granted to provide quasi-municipal water service to one parcel described as Clark County Assessor's Parcel (APN) 176-14-801-012.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.06 cubic feet per second, **and not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

March 23, 2007

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 23, 2007

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

March 23, 2011

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

April 23, 2011

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
