The applicant **Andy Jordan, an unmarried Man** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of diversion Place of use of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit #13691, certificate #5131**

1. The source of water is **underground source**
2. The amount of water to be changed **3.5 acres 17.5 AFA .035 cfs**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation and Domestic Use**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic Use**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, T.20S, R.53E., M.D.B.&M., Nye County, Nevada at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 33 bears S 77° 56' 50" W a distance of 1770.87'**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **The NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section -1, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., Nye County, Nevada at a point from which the NE corner of said Section -1 bears N 43° 30' 00" a distance of 195.00 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **Consisting of 3.5 acres within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, T.20S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., Nye County, Nevada known as A.P.N. #35-541-02 being Lot #6 of Paloverde Rancho's Subdivision as shown on Doc #88391 record'd 8-16-83 Nye Co. Recorder Office.**
8. Existing place of use **3.5 acres to be removed within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., Nye County, Nevada**
9. Use will be from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Proposed well, submergible pump, presure tank, totalizing meter and distribution system**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$10,000 dollars**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **2-years**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5-years**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 13691, Certificate 5131, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 13691, Certificate 5131, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Any application to change the manner of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the ground water basin.

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The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.035 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 17.5 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

March 6, 2008


Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
