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The applicant **Christopher S. Boyajian** hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of diversion Place of use** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit #68799**

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1. The source of water is **Underground source**
2. The amount of water to be changed **40.85 AFA 0.1 CFS**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation and Domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **Within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, T.20S.,R.53E., M.D.B.&M., Nye County, Nevada at a point from which the East  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 30 bears N 44°21'53" E a distance of 70.55' feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **The NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29, T.20S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., Nye County, Nevada at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 29 bears N 10°02'27" W a distance of 190.89' feet**
7. Proposed place of use **within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, T.20S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., Nye County, Nevada being APN# 36-451-14 consisting of 41.039 acres.**
8. Existing place of use **within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30 T.20S.,R.53E., M.D.B.&M., being 41.039 acres and a portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29, T.20S.,R.53E., M.D.B.&M., also known as Lot - 3, Block-1 Calvada Valley Unit #5 being (1.125 acres) the portion to be removed from irrigation**
9. Use will be from **January 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup>** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup>** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Proposed well casing, submergible pump, totalizing meter, pressure tank and distribution system**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$10,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **2-years**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5- years**

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 68799 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 68799 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 73188 and 73189 shall not exceed 56.55 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 11.31 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second, **and not to exceed 40.85 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

**April 11, 2008**

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

**May 11, 2008**

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

**April 11, 2010**

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

**May 11, 2010**


