The applicant **Southwest Desert Equities, LLC; Attention John Ritter**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Place and Manner of Use of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 52178, Certificate 13514**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.0072 c.f.s.; 5.00 Acre Feet**
3. The water to be used for **Quasi-Municipal**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T.19S., R.60E., MDM or at a point from which the East $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of said Section 32 bears North 74° 32' 34" East a distance of 1,252.95 feet.**
6. The existing point of diversion is located within **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T.19S., R.60E., MDM or at a point from which the Northeast Corner of said Section 27 bears North 61° 12' 26" East, a distance of 1,140.21 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.M. in Clark County, NV.**
8. Existing place of use **within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T.19S., R.60E., MDM, Clark Co., NV (The westerly 0.733 acres to be removed by this Application) from the 1.1 total acres as shown on C. 13514 and PBU map filed 2/19/1992 under Permit 52177.**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Well, pump motor, water meter and distribution piping**
12. Estimated cost of works **in excess of \$10,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **works are constructed**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 52178, Certificate 13514, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 52178, Certificate 13514, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 65471, 73335 and 73336 shall not exceed 13.03 acre-feet annually.

Permit 73335 is granted to provide quasi-municipal water service to four parcels described as Clark County Assessor's Parcels (APN) 125-32-703-001, 125-32-703-002, 125-32-703-005, and 125-32-703-006.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0072 cubic feet per second, **and not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet annually.**


