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#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This amended permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 11537, Certificate 4996, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 11537, Certificate 4996 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 59604, 59605, 59606, 64043, 64044, 64574, 64575, 65101, 65562, 65715, 66829, 67016, 67950, 69430, 71363, 71937, 71938, 72967, 73592, 73593, 73646, 73647, 73691, and 76361, being owned by Desert Utilities, Inc. and having the same place of use, shall not exceed 11.79 cubic feet per second and 2,794.99 acre-feet annually. Permits 64574 and 64575 are for backup water only and do not add to the total combined duty of water.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 59605, 64043, 64574, 65562, 65715, 66829, 67950, 71937, 72967, 73592, 73691 and 76361, having the same point of diversion (Well #4), shall not exceed 4.563 cubic feet per second and 1,324.09 acre-feet annually.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

Any dedication of water from this permit for residential service shall be allocated at the per lot or unit duty prescribed, by letter dated November 4, 2008, by the State Engineer. The State Engineer may amend this dedicated allocation based on evidence and supporting data.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 1.2752 cubic feet per second but not to exceed 382.55 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:



The total combined duty of water under Permits 59605, 64043, 64574, 65562, 65715, 66829, 67950, 71937, 72967, and 73592, having the same point of diversion (Well #4), shall not exceed 4.6437 cubic feet per second and 1132.58 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.



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The applicant **Desert Utilities, Inc.** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Place and Manner of Use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 11537, Certificate 4996**

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1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **1.2752 c.f.s. (382.55 AFA)**
3. The water to be used for **Municipal**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 21, T.19S., R.53E., MDM., or at a point from which the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 21 bears North 44° 17' 57" East., a distance of 3,883.46 feet (DUI Well #4)**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 21, T.19S., R.53E., M.D.M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 21 bears N. 45° E., a distance of 100 feet.**

Existing place of use **NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  (0 acres remaining – all 40 certificated acres stripped under Permit 62038), E $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  (76.51 acres remaining – 80 certificated acres less 2.12 acres stripped under Permit 62038 and 1.37 acres stripped under Permit 71750), Section 21, T.19S., R.53E., M.D.M.
