APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 67604 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 67604 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 55936, 55937, Certificate 14257; Permit 55938, Certificate 14258; Permit 55939, Certificate 15080; Permit 55940, Certificate 14259; Permit 55941, Certificate 15081; Permit 55942, Certificate 14260; Permits 59601, 61150, 61588, 61590, 66543, 66544, 66853, 66956, 66957, 67013, 67014, 68089, 68090, 68716, 69061, 69062, 69588, 71414, 71415, 71231, 71232, 73636, 73637, 73638, and 73639 shall not exceed 1259.6681 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.016 cubic feet per second or 11.37 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 14, 2011

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

April 14, 2020


