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The applicant **Haddan Family Trust** hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. **Trust dated 12/21/2000 – James Philip Haddan, Diane Evelyn Haddan, Co-Trustees**

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1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **Underground**
2. The amount of water applied for is **.03 c.f.s. (2.02 acre-feet)** second-feet
  - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for **Commercial and Domestic**
4. If use is for:
  - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated
  - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered
  - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")
  - (d) Power:
    - (1) Horsepower developed
    - (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point **SE ¼ NE¼ Section 5, T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 5 bears N. 16 degrees 49' 08"., a distance of 2082.90 feet.**
6. Place of Use **Portion of the SE ¼ NE ¼, Parcel S-3, Section 5, T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.& M., Lyon County, Nevada. APN 016-312-11 (Parcel 2, Doc. #192322)**
7. Use will begin about **January 1** and end about **December 31** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **Drilled well, pump and pipelines to place of use**
9. Estimated cost of works **\$5,000.00**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **3 years**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**

12. Remarks: Water is to be used only on APN 016-312-11 (Parcel 2, Doc. #192322) and the place of use is not to be moved or expanded upon. This application will not result in an increase in consumptive use. We plan to remodel the 720 s.f. existing garage/storage on our property for use as an office/guest quarters and Lyon County requires that water rights be secured for this remodel.

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer by February 15th of each year.

The issuance of this permit is for commercial service at the described place of use. Any future attempt to change the place of use and manner of use of this permit will be denied.

The domestic and commercial use cannot exceed 2.02 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 0.73 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

September 22, 2007

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

October 22, 2007

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

September 22, 2009

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

October 22, 2009

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
