APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 66599 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 66599 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis within 30 days after the end of each calendar year.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 66597, Certificate 16353; Permits 66598, 66599, 66600, Certificate 16354; Permits 66601, 66602, and 74404 shall not exceed 3824.81 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 956.18 acres.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 66602 and 74404 shall not exceed 1290.08 acre feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use is as described under items 5 and 7 respectively on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.739 cubic feet per second or 534.88 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 23, 2008

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

The applicant **High Rock Holding, LLC**, a Nevada Limited Liability Company hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion** of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 66599**

1. The source of water is **Underground (Well #18)**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.739 cfs, not to exceed 534.79 acre-feet annually**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **SE¼ SW¼, Section 36, T.36N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 11, T.35N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., bears S.21°28'02"W., a distance of 3411.71 feet. (Refer to map filed under Permit 66597).**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **NE¼ NW¼ Section 36, T.36N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 11, T.35N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., bears S.08°53'36"W., a distance of 8,503.92 feet. (Refer to map filed under Permit 66597).**

11. Description of proposed works **Existing drilled and cased well, equipped with a motor, pump, meter, and distribution system.**
