APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 66706 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 66706 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 66704, 66705, 66706, 66707 and 74405 shall not exceed 1,857.6 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 464.4 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 3.06 cubic feet per second or 1100.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





The applicant **High Rock Holding, LLC**, a Nevada Limited Liability Company hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion of a portion of water** heretofore appropriated under **Permit 66706**

1. The source of water is **Underground (Well #21)**
2. The amount of water to be changed **3.06 cfs, not to exceed 1100 acre feet annually**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, T.35N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 19 bears S.45°50'40"W., a distance of 1873.12 feet. (Refer to Map filed under Permit 66800)**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **Lot 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 19, T35N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 19 bears N.01°03'W., a distance of 1235.2 feet (Refer to map filed under Permit 23519)**
7. Proposed place of use **Unchanged**
8. Existing place of use **N $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 24, T.35N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 19, T.35N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M., 464.40 acres total. (Refer to map filed under Permit 66704)**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **An existing drilled and cased well, equipped with a motor, pump, meter, and distribution system.**
12. Estimated cost of works **Completed under 66603**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Completed under Permit 66603**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **Five (5) Years**

15. Remarks: Well 20 is unable to produce the full extent of water under Permit 66706, and thus this application is being filed to transfer a portion of this right to Well 21. The total combined duty of this application and Permits 66704 through 66707 shall not exceed 1857.6 acre-feet. The total combined duty of Permits 66800, 66802, and 66806 is unchanged.
