APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 25900, Certificate 7799, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 25900, Certificate 7799, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 71541 and 74450 shall not exceed 20.43 acre-feet per year.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

The point of diversion and place of use is as described under items 5 and 7 respectively on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0045 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 2.02 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

August 8, 2008

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

August 8, 2010

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

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The applicant **White Pine County** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Manner of Use and Place of Use of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit No. 25900, Certificate No. 7799 Permit No. 25900** was certificated as a change to **Permit No. 25025**

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1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.0045 cfs**
3. The water to be used for **Commercial**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Quasi-Municipal**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **In the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 15, T.17N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 15 bears S. 45° 15' 18" E., a distance of 2,363.39 feet. As shown on Application Map 52694.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 36, T.17N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 36 bears S. 27° 10' W., a distance of 4,495 feet. As shown on Application to change Map 25900.**
7. Proposed place of use **All of T.17N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., The East half of T.18N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. and the West half of T.18N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.**
8. Existing place of use **Portions of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 36, T.17N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **An existing 8" well will be used and the water pumped into a pipeline which will provide water for the Lackawanna Fire Station for domestic and cleaning uses within the station.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$10,000.00**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **2 Years**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **6 year**
