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The applicant **Vincent James Daly** hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. **N/A**

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1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **Underground**
2. The amount of water applied for is **2.02 AFA; 0.003 cfs** second-feet
  - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for **Commercial**
4. If use is for:

The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point **Within the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 15, Township 20 S., Range 53 E., M.D.B.&M., at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 15 bears S 03° 03' 21" E a distance of 1204.41 feet.**
6. Place of Use **Within a portion of the E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 15, Township 20 S, Range 53 E., M.D.B.&M., Nye County, Nevada. Also known as Nye County Assessor's Parcel Number 35-344-02, also known as Bolling Green Acres Block 4, Lot 1, as shown on document #56007 dated 05/19/1966, located at 730 S. West Street, Pahrump, Nevada.**
7. Use will begin about **January 1<sup>st</sup>** and end about **December 31<sup>st</sup>** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **Well with casing, submersible pump, motor, storage tank, distribution system, and totalizing meter**
9. Estimated cost of works **\$15,000 associated with works, as listed in item #8**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **2 years**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**
12. Remarks: **Fencing business including office with restrooms and kitchen area, fabrication shop with triple sink and floor sink, yard area with hose bibs, a small truck wash area, and possible misting system in break area. Water will also be used for dust control and landscaping. Applicant with purchase additional water rights if the actual use demands such.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued under the provisions of NRS 534.120(2) as a preferred use.

Permit 74497 is issued for commercial water service to the parcel identified by the Nye County Assessor as APN 35-344-02. Upon cessation of pumping for commercial purposes at this place of use, the water under Permit 74497, shall return to the groundwater source and no application to change or relinquishment will be allowed

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.003 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 2.02 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

March 2, 2008

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

March 2, 2010

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
