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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 60431, Certificate 15631, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 60431, Certificate 15631 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

The point of diversion and place of use is as described under items 5 and 7 respectively on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0389 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 9.08 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

August 7, 2008

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

August 7, 2009

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- 1. The source of water is Underground, Amargosa Desert Basin 230, Nye County
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.0389 CFS, 9.08 AF
3. The water to be used for Commercial
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation & Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 15, T.16S. R.48E, MDB&M and From which point the NW Corner of said Section 15 bears N. 26°16'19" W. a distance of 2331 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within
7. Proposed place of use NE 1/4 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 SECTION 15, T.16S. R48E, MDB&M 2.5 Acres
8. Existing place of use NE 1/4 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 15, T.16S. R.48E. MDB&M, 2.5 Acres, all 2.5 acres to be removed from irrigation as shown on POD Change map item #48 filed under Permit 60162
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Existing infrastructure to be modified to support material handling. New pipes to be added to existing well.
12. Estimated cost of works \$18,000
13. Estimated time required to construct works One Year
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use
15. Remarks: Annual consumptive use expected not to exceed 10 Acre Feet. Exact number of connections not known as existing trees and irrigated areas will be watered to support the landscape and raw materials for the commercial operation in addition to the processing of agricultural and food products and byproducts.
