APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 39555, Certificate 11573 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 39555, Certificate 11573 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 20628, Certificate 7447; Permit 34725, Certificate 9819; Permit 38859, Certificate 11398; Permits 49045, 63469, 74693, 74694, 74695, 74696, 74905 and 77228 shall not exceed 798.00 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0204 cubic feet per second or 14.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 19, 2009

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



The applicant **Indian Springs Water Co., Inc.** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Place and Manner of Use of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 39555, Certificate 11573**

1. The source of water is **underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.0204 c.f.s. (not to exceed 14.0 A.F.A.)**
3. The water to be used for **Municipal**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **within Tract 47B, T.16 S., R. 56 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Tract 47B bears N. 31°00'30" E., a distance of 231 feet; in Clark County, NV. (Indian Springs Water Co. Well #2)**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SW¼SW¼ Section 9, T. 16S., R. 56E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Tract 48 B of supplemental Plat No. 2 of resurvey of said Township bears N. 80°26'04" W., a distance of 1,010.36 feet; in Clark County, Nevada.**
7. Proposed place of use **Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16, 17, & 18; all within T. 16S., R. 56E., M.D.M.; in Clark County, Nevada. (Indian Springs Water Co., Inc. water service area)**
8. Existing place of use **3.62 acres within the SW¼ SW¼ Section 9, T. 16S., R. 56E., M.D.M. and 1.32 acres within the SE¼ SW ¼ Section 9, T. 16S., R. 56E., M.D.M. (being APN 059-09-401-013 in Tract 48B) This Application will strip the westerly 2.8 acres of APN 059-09-401-013 within the SW¼ SW¼ Section 9, T.16S., R. 56E., M.D.M., as shown on accompanying stripping map.**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **drilled well, storage tank and distribution system**
