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The applicant **Intermountain Water Supply, Ltd** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Place of Use of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 66873**

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1. The source of water is **Underground Water-Well**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.75 cfs (100af)**
3. The water to be used for **Municipal and Domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Municipal and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 23 T. 23 N., R.19E., MDB&M or at a point from which the NE Corner of said Sec 23 bears N. 10° 19' 18" E., a distance of 486.33 feet**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 5 T.23N., R.19E., MDB&M or at a point from which the SE Corner of said section 5 bears S. 40° E., a distance of 550 feet**
7. Proposed place of use **Pipeline Route from Honey Lake Valley to Lemmon Valley via Dry Valley Bedell Flat and Antelope Valley. From a map of proposed POU, use map on file under Permit 74872-T**
8. Existing place of use **All of T 21 N., R. 19 E. Sec 36, T 21 N., R. 18 E., Sec 1 through 12, 15, 16 and 17 T. 20 N., R. 19E., Sec 1 and 12 T. 20N., R. 18E., all MDB & M. For a map of the existing POU use map on file under Permit 64073**
9. Use will be from **December of 2006 to November 2007** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup>** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Drilled well, pump, motor and haul trucks**
12. Estimated cost of works **estimate: \$100,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **2 months**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **1 year**
15. Remarks: **Water will be taken by haul trucks to be used for dust control and compaction for the pipeline from Honey Lake to Lemmon Valley via Dry Valley, Bedell Flat, Antelope Valley**

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 66873 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 66873, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on February 15th of each year.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire one year from the date of approval at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.75 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 100.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:


