APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 68114 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 68114 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 75136, 75137, 75138, 75139, 75140, and 75141 shall not exceed 30.72 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 75136, 75137, 75138, 75139, 75140, and 75141 and any water from Ophir Creek and Davis Creek, shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for the irrigation of 7.68 acres within the described place of use. The surface waters must be used in their entirety before any groundwater can be pumped from the wells to complete the allocated duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre.

Measuring devices must be installed, maintained and measured of all water diversions from Ophir and Davis Creeks and reported to the State Engineer within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The point of diversion and place of use is as described under items 5 & 7 respectively on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0273 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 14.325 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

June 1, 2008

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


