The applicant **Lyon County, c/o Lyon County Utilities** hereby make(s) application for permission to change the **Point of diversion and Place of use** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 72801**

3. The water to be used for **Quasi-Municipal**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Quasi-Municipal**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NE¼ NE¼ Section 32, T. 17 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 32 bears N. 11° 54' 00" E., a distance of 901.0 feet (D.V.E. #3)**

Lyon County Utilities is in agreement to serve water to Parcel, APN 19-265-07, for Quasi-Municipal Purposes. The proposed project consists of a church building with associated landscaping.
