APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Permit 58947, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Claim 654, Truckee River Decree, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

Not more than 20% of the flow of Galena Creek to a maximum of 3.3034 cubic feet per second may be diverted from point of diversion #2 (north diversion point) under 65729, 65730, 75389T, 75390T, 75391T, and 75392T.

The issuance of this permit is for the consumptive use portion only, being 2.5 acre-feet per acre of the base right consistent with State Engineer's Ruling #5359 dated 6/03/04, or 13.44 acre-feet, of the 24.19 acre-foot portion of the base right. The remainder, 10.75 acre-feet, remains in the source. The issuance of this permit abrogates 24.19 acre-feet from Permit 58947.

This permit is subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation of the Federal Water Master.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on October 15, 2007 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use is as described under items 5 & 7 respectively on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.1344 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 13.44 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:
