APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.025 cubic feet per second, herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which has customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Irrigation under this permit is limited to 5.0 acres within the described place of use.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.025 cubic feet per second or 20.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and all sources.

- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before: October 25, 2009
Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before: October 25, 2012
Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before: October 25, 2012
