APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 53195, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 53195 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire one year from approval at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The total combined duty of Claim 01864, Permit 2552, Certificate 478; Permit 2964, 53193 through 53204, inclusive and Temporary Permits 75362T and 75767T shall not exceed 13,024.8 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 3256.2 acres within the described place of use.

The point of diversion and place of use is as described under items 5 and 7 respectively on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 750.4 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before: N/A

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before: N/A

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before: N/A
