This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 62321, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 62321 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.041 cubic feet per second or 29.68 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 28, 2009

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

April 28, 2011

Therefore, this application is filed to allow the existing Brook Spring Well (see log 39892) near the spring to supply water to the spring until it recovers from dewatering sufficiently for the proposed (historic) beneficial use.*
