APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 68521 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 68521 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 76036 and 76037 shall not exceed 401.85 acre-feet for the irrigation of 133.95 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Temporary permit 75699T expires with the approval of this permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.7014 cubic feet per second or 150.3 acre-feet annually and not to exceed a yearly duty of 3.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

November 14, 2008

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

November 16, 2009

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

November 16, 2009

Question 5 - The existing point of diversion of Permit 18869, Certificate 6832 and the proposed point of diversion of a portion of Permit 68521 is an existing well which was shown on the Certificate for permit 18869, Certificate 6832, as being located at a point from which the Northeast corner of section 29, T.29 N., R.52 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N 82° 30' 00" E, 2894.00 feet. The Northeast corner of said Section 29 has been destroyed. The position of the existing well under Permit 18869, Certificate 6832 was re-surveyed and is located at a point from which the East 1/4 corner of Section 21, T.29 N., R.52 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N 69° 21' 12" E, 8855.47 feet.

Question 7 and 8 - The waters under this application are to be co-mingled with the waters on the accompanying application to change the place of use of Permit 18869, Certificate 6832 to irrigate a total of 133.95 acres within the proposed place of use . The area to be irrigated is shown below:
