APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 61882 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 61882 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet or the first confining layer, whichever is greater.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 76201 and 76202 shall not exceed 24.8 acre-feet for the irrigation of 6.2 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.07516 cubic feet per second or 16.8 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before: September 18, 2011

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before: September 18, 2013

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before: September 18, 2013


