APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 54667 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 54667 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 60739, 60740, 60741, 60742, 63538, 63539, 63540, 63541, 76313 and 76314, having the same point of diversion and a comingled place of use, shall not exceed 1.775 cubic feet per second and 678.82 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

This permit is issued for quasi-municipal purposes to serve the recreation (golf course irrigation) needs of the Bad Lands Golf Course, which is further described as the 179.20 acre golf course parcel identified by the Clark County Assessor as APN 138-31-713-002.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.067 cubic feet per second or 27.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

June 25, 2009

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 25, 2011

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
