APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of the waters of Glenbrook Creek and Tributaries, as heretofore appropriated under Permit 52271, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of Glenbrook Creek and Tributaries as heretofore appropriated under Proof 02148 as appears in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights of the Claimants and Appropriators in and to the waters of Glenbrook Creek and its Tributaries, in the District Court of the First (now 9th) Judicial District of the State of Nevada, in and for the County of Douglas, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of the water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.003 cubic feet per second or 1.0 acre-feet annually.**


