APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 60612, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 60612 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 46295, 53139, 53140, 64131, 76666, 77626 and 77627 shall not exceed 544.34 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.025 cubic feet per second or 4.04 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:



EXHIBIT "C"**Item # 15 Remarks:**

A portion of the water under 60612, 4.04 acre-feet, was obtained by Douglas County in conjunction with the Carol J and Louis Domingo Uhart parcel map, recorded November 30, 2004, parent APN 1321-29-002-024. The actual map condition, was that the applicant submit an Affidavit of Withdrawal for Domestic Well Credit on the 4.04 acre-feet to the State DWR.

For reasons unknown, the Engineer for the applicant, RO Anderson Engineering, instead, dedicated this water to Douglas County, leaving the water in the Gardnerville Water Company water system, and in one of the Gardnerville Water Company Wells.

Douglas County attempted to relinquish the 4.04 acre-feet of water through an Affidavit of Withdrawal for Domestic Well Credit, submitting said Affidavit to the State DWR October 17, 2007.

The Affidavit was rejected by the State December 6, 2007.

This application to change is now being filed, moving the water into a well within the West Valley (Genoa) Water System, where the water can be put to beneficial use.
