This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Permit 11489, Certificate 4827, which changed the point of diversion of Claim 236, Truckee River Decree, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on October 31, 2008, at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.6789 cubic feet per second or 64.84 acre-feet as decreed.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:



Item 15: The City of Reno is performing sewer rehabilitation project by slip-lining. Water is necessary to the process to cure the lining material. From most locations throughout the 25,500 feet of sewer that will be slip-lined, a convenient source of water is available. However, for the major sewer interceptor through the Rosewood Lakes area, water from Boynton Slough may be needed. Once the material has cured, the water will then released into the sewer where it will pass through the Truckee Meadows Water Reclamation Facility and back to the river. Attached is a description of the City's Sewer Rehab Project.
