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**APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 56588 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 56588 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 7381, 9446, 10185, 14474, 14475, 14476, 14477, 15979, 23985, 24801, 26326, 29061, 36626, 37221, 43373, 43374, 44073, 48277, 49515, 49617, 51994, 51995, 52854, 54142, 56588, 56589, 56590, 59766, 61635, 61712, 61714, 62908, 64180, 64579, 67161 and 76774-T shall not exceed 18,000 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The permittee shall report to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis the effect of pumping the well under this temporary permit on other previously existing wells that are located within 2,500 feet of the well under this temporary permit. Any pumping of water under this temporary permit may be limited or prohibited to prevent any unreasonable adverse effects on an existing domestic well located within 2,500 feet of the well under this temporary permit, unless the holder of this temporary permit and the owner of the domestic well have agreed to alternative measures that mitigate adverse effects.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.


